# 1.4 Application

Coloured versions on white background



In principle, the use of the coloured versions on a white background is recommended.

#### Black and negative versions





Where for technical reasons the coloured representation of the logos is impossible, the version black or (with dark background) negative can be used.

# 3. Labelling and certification marks/labels

## 3.1 Principle

The respective certification mark/label may be used to declare certification/endorsement on packaging, labels, flyers, websites, etc. In the case of improper use and after an unsuccessful written warning, the client may lose the right to use the certification marks. We reserve the right to assert a claim for injunctive relief and to claim damages in the event of unauthorised labelling.

#### A Labelling only with contractual relation

The labelling may only be used by companies that have a valid contractual relation with Carbon Standards International AG.

#### B Labelling only with valid certification

Products labelled with the mark must also have valid certifications.

#### C Labelling with certification marks EBC, WBC and World-Climate Farm

The regulations set out in the standards apply to the use of the certification marks listed below.



EBC: see chapter 12 in the EBC Standards



WBC: see chapter 11 in the WBC Standards



WCF: see chapter 11 in the WCF Standards

# 3.2 Labelling types

Either the certification mark/label or text can be used for labelling.

#### A Labelling with certification mark/label

We recommend using the certification mark/label for labelling.

If labelling with the certification mark/label is not possible, the label and the certification body must be stated. For the best possible customer information, we recommend labelling according to the example on the right.
