

Procedure for public consultation on the development of projects and governmental programs concerning standards for carbon sinks

Publishing

- Project owner: sends the Project Design Document (PDD) to Carbon Standards.
- Carbon Standards: starts the public consultation by publishing the name of the project, the publication date and methodology together with the PDD on its website (www.carbon-standards.com)

Collecting feedback

- Carbon Standards: keeps public consultation open for 1 month
- Carbon Standards: collects all the feedback and publishs them on its website

- Project owner: provides its comments on the feedbacks and modifies the PDD
- Carbon Standards: keeps the PDDs and the feedbacks available on its website for 2 months

 CERES-CERT: checks the updated PDD with the comments of the project owner and validates the implementation of the feedbacks during inspection.
