

Guide to Creating a Farmer Declaration

Farmer declaration is created with the hope that farmers promise to cease any open field crop waste burning and adapt biochar production and application instead. Artisan C-Sink Managers should provide an English version of the document. Once the certifier accepts the document, the C-Sink Manager can translate it into the local farmer's language.

Farmer declaration should at least contain the following:

- Name
- National ID number
- Country

Artisan C-Sink Managers should help explain the content of the declaration. A thumb stamp or signature under the document is sufficient. The declaration has no expiration date; however, its essence needs to be enforced periodically.
